4. US COPYRIGHT OFFICE SOON TO HAVE ONLINE REGISTRATIONS !

The U.S. Copyright Office is going to make online registration available, including the registration of individual titles on every CD (if I understood correctly). Supposedly, it will make registration faster and cost less (although if you read the fine print...)

July 2007 is the target date unless Congress acts against it.

5. COOL FREE SOFTWARE DOWNLOAD

Have you ever tried to send something in email, and the receiver couldn't open it, read it or print it out? Now you can print everything to a PDF document, so it can be read by Adobe Acrobat, which every computer has (or can also get for free).

It's called "CutePDF Writer" and they provide a freeware version. The software sets itself up as a printer. So when you're done typing that short story you plan to send me, you can go to "print", choose CutePDF, name it, save it and ...Voila!.

It will turn your story into a PDF document, which you can send through email as an attachment, put on your website, save a copy of a webpage to your computer instead of printing a hard copy, and other uses I may not have thought of. You may be able to do this with pictures, too, although I haven't tried it.
