So, why download if you can hear a music track online? Well, you don't have to!

BUT, some people prefer to accumulate music tracks on their computer so they can listen to them all at once. It's easier than bookmarking every site and hopping around the internet every 3 minutes trying to play the music tracks that you like.

You can also take your accumulated music library and "burn" it to a CD. Then you have the freedom to play it in your car while driving to work or play it on your stereo system - on better speakers than your computer might have!

You can even load your music choices into your MP3 player and listen while you're waiting at the dentist's office!

You have complete control over what you load onto the CD. It doesn't

have to be all one artist or one genre of music. It doesn't even all have to be music - how about an audio story!

The answer: convenience and freedom of choice (and better speakers).
